What toys did your parents and grandparents play with? Draw a picture of a toy they used to have and a toy that you play with now. Write down any differences that you notice.

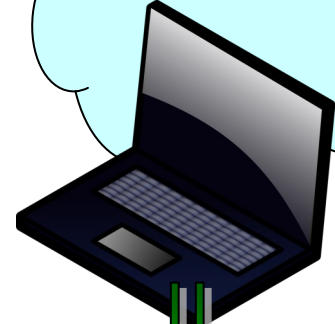
As mathematicians...

As readers...

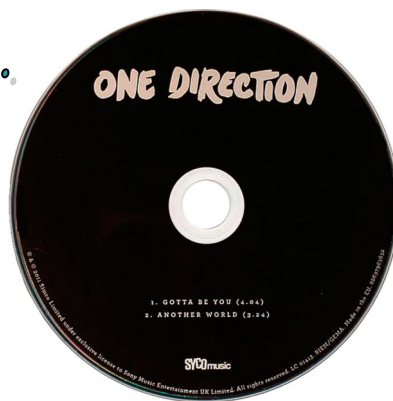
