



Class Dojo Code of Conduct



Purpose:

Encourages students: Class Dojo gives students' positive feedback for any skill, relating to Brownsover Values and Behaviour Policy.

School community and family engagement: Teachers can share photos, videos, and more with parents. Parents can see their child's feedback instantly using any device. By school and parents working together; the best possible outcome for their child can be achieved.

Free and works on any device: Class Dojo is free and works on any iOS/Android/Kindle Fire device or web browser. Parents can also read all Class Story posts in their preferred language instantly.

Class Dojo is safe: All information on Class Dojo is private between teachers, parents and students. Class Dojo permanently deletes students' personal information when they stop using Class Dojo. Teachers, parents and students can always access and delete their information at any time.

Showing our Core Values on Class Dojo...

- Everyone must only post positive and supportive comments on stories, pictures and in messages. Any concerns must be raised in person/by telephone. Appreciating that teachers focus is teaching and that they may not be able to respond immediately.
- Celebrate work, points earned and home learning activities. Share things that you are proud of from home!
- For parents, teachers and children to work together to support learning, behaviours, contribution to Core Values and celebrate success.
- All must follow the set hours to send messages and sending messages to share basic information. Class Dojo content shouldn't be posted on any Social Media platforms.

Parent's Code of Conduct:

- Parents can use a generated invite code to link with their child's class, either through the use of the smart phone app or website,
- Only parents or legal guardians will be given access codes to Class Dojo. It is expected that up to two parents will be linked to a child's account; any additional adults will only be accepted in special circumstances,
- By using Class Dojo, you agree to the terms set out in this usage agreement,
- Parents can view their child's points total and story feed. They can also message their child's class teacher; this is where the following stipulations apply to keep all parties safe and use the tool to its advantages:

1. Parents can message teachers; however, a response will only be given during the hours of 8am – 4:30pm Monday-Friday as the rest of the time teachers are set on 'quiet time',
2. Parents should be aware that an immediate response cannot be expected, as the main priority of staff is to teach, and a response will be given as soon as possible, during the working hours,
3. The following matters should always go through to our Main Office and will not be responded to by teachers: absence, sickness, school dinner enquiries, collection arrangements and complaints,
4. Parents should not use this messaging tool to enquire about the progress of their child or behaviour but can use it to arrange a meeting or telephone conversation with class teachers to discuss any questions they may have.
5. Parents must ensure that all communication is positive. Offensive, inappropriate or threatening language will not be tolerated.
6. Parents must not share any content (messages, photographs, activities) of Class Dojo on any of their social media platforms.

Parents who do not use the messaging correctly will be given warnings and where necessary, be taken off Class Dojo.

Breaches of the Class Dojo Code of Conduct by children, parents and teachers will be referred to a member of Senior Leadership Team on an individual basis.
