As we finalise the year, we are busy arranging transition events to support our pupils as they prepare for their next school or classes. Please note County Induction/Transition Day is a day where children across the County get to experience their new classrooms/teachers, ready for September.

Current Year 2

Children in Year 2 will receive a letter shortly requiring parents to complete their child's destination school and plans for the day. Please make sure you return this by the deadline, Monday 16 June 2025. If any of your child's Year 3 plans change after this date please make sure you update the office immediately.

Current Nursery

Joining us in Reception - School letters were sent home on the 8 May 2025, which included an invitation on County Induction Day for your child to join us on the 2 July from 9.00-11.30am to experience Reception class. Please check the arrangements.

Nursery children who are moving to another setting in September, please note Bridges letters will be sent home shortly. Please note Bridges morning Nursery class is cancelled and only those children who will be visiting Reception should attend.

Reception, Year 1 & Year 5

Children in these classes will come into school as normal and once registration is completed they will then move through to their new classroom and spend time with their new teacher.

Year 2 & Year 6 Teachers, Wednesday 16 July at 2.45pm (Current Year 1 & 5 Parents)

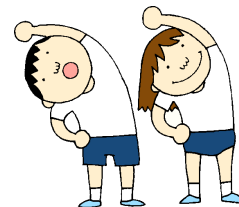

Reception Sports Day



Thursday 3 July, 9.30 - 10.30am

Please remember if you are taking your child out of school for a medical appointment we will require a copy of the appointment letter/notification. Thank you

Important—Parental Responsibilities

Please note it is the responsibility of Parents/Guardians to ensure that the school is kept up to date with the following items:

- Your **Current Address**.
- **Up to date Contact Telephone Numbers** for yourselves and other emergency contacts.
- Any **Court Ordered Change of Parental Responsibility** (copy of order required).
- Any **Medical Conditions** and changes to them (particularly those with long-term medical conditions ie Asthma or severe allergies requiring use of epi-pen).
- Any **Dietary Requirements** including food allergies, religious choices and lifestyle choices. Please note we require this information even when your child is having packed lunches as we do food tasting and cookery etc in school.

Lost Property

The lost property box in the main lobby is filling up again. Please can you check and see if anything belongs to your child.

The contents of the box will be disposed of at the end of the school year if they remain uncollected.

It is really important that all your child's belongings are clearly labelled with your child's name to ensure they don't go missing.



Parking

Please could we ask

- That you are respectful of our neighbours and other parents/carers
- Do not park over/on their drives
- Leave enough room either side of the neighbours drives so that they can safely pull off them.
- Do not park on the corners of the junctions (The Highway code states you should not be any closer to a junction than 10 meters (32 feet) (approx. 2.5 cars lengths)
- Do not obstruct the school entrance gates or the pathway either side

Please be mindful of your behaviour and ensure that you speak to other pedestrians and vehicle drivers with respect, particularly in front of our children. Raised voices and swearing are unacceptable and do not demonstrate the school

values that children are learning to follow. Remember, children learn by example.

Get help to buy food and milk

(the Healthy Start scheme)

What is Healthy Start?

If you're more than 10 weeks pregnant or have a child under 4, you may be entitled to get help to buy healthy food and milk.

If you're eligible, you'll be sent a Healthy Start card with money on it that you can use in some UK shops. We'll add your benefit onto this card every 4 weeks.

You can use your card to buy:

- plain liquid cow's milk
- fresh, frozen, and tinned fruit and vegetables
- fresh, dried, and tinned pulses
- infant formula milk based on cow's milk

You can also use your card to collect:

- Healthy Start vitamins – these support you during pregnancy and breastfeeding
- vitamin drops for babies and young children – these are suitable from birth to 4 years old
