## Nursery/Year 2 Parents - Make sure you have your child's Reception/Year 3 Offer

If your child is **currently in Nursery or Year 2** and you didn't receive anything, you should check via the portal or contact Warwickshire County Council Admissions for further information

This year offers will be automatically accepted unless you decline them.

## Important—Parental Responsibilities

Please note it is the responsibility of Parents/Guardians to ensure that the school is kept up to date with the following items:

- Your **Current Address**.
- **Up to date Contact Telephone Numbers** for yourselves and other emergency contacts.
- Any **Court Ordered Change of Parental Responsibility** (copy of order required).
- Any **Medical Conditions** and changes to them (particularly those with long-term medical conditions ie Asthma or severe allergies requiring use of epi-pen).
- Any **Dietary Requirements** including food allergies, religious choices and lifestyle choices. Please note we require this information even when your child is having packed lunches as we do food tasting and cookery etc in school.

It is really important that all your child's belongings are clearly labelled with your child's name to ensure they don't go missing.



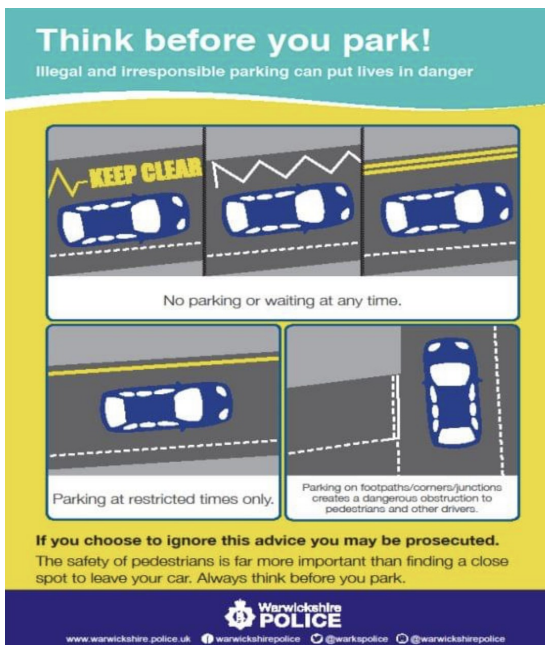
## Parking



Please could we ask

- That you are respectful of our neighbours and other parents/carers
- Do not park over/on their drives
- Leave enough room either side of the neighbours drives so that they can safely pull off them.
- Do not park on the corners of the junctions (The Highway code states you should not be any closer to a junction than 10 meters (32 feet) (approx. 2.5 cars lengths)
- Do not obstruct the school entrance gates or the pathway either side

Please be mindful of your behaviour and ensure that you speak to other pedestrians and vehicle drivers with respect, particularly in front of our children. Raised voices and swearing are unacceptable and do not demonstrate the school values that children are learning to follow. Remember, children learn by example.

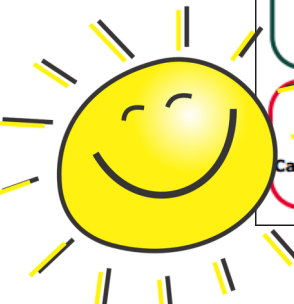

### Get help to buy food and milk

(the Healthy Start scheme)

#### What is Healthy Start?

If you're more than 10 weeks pregnant or have a child under 4, you may be entitled to get help to buy healthy food and milk.

If you're eligible, you'll be sent a Healthy Start card with money on it that you can use in some UK shops. We'll add your benefit onto this card every 4 weeks.

You can use your card to buy:

- plain liquid cow's milk
- fresh, frozen, and tinned fruit and vegetables
- fresh, dried, and tinned pulses
- infant formula milk based on cow's milk

You can also use your card to collect:

- Healthy Start vitamins – these support you during pregnancy and breastfeeding
- vitamin drops for babies and young children – these are suitable from birth to 4 years old
